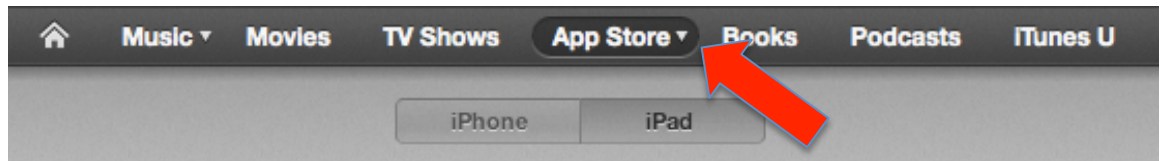
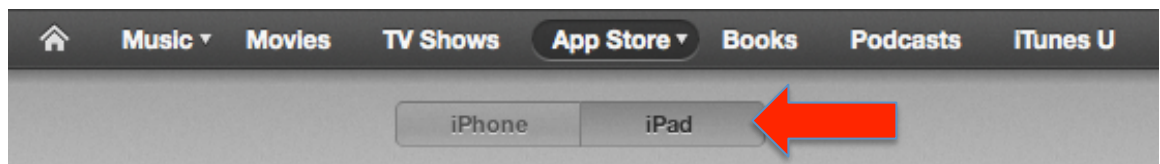


Create Apple ID without a Credit Card

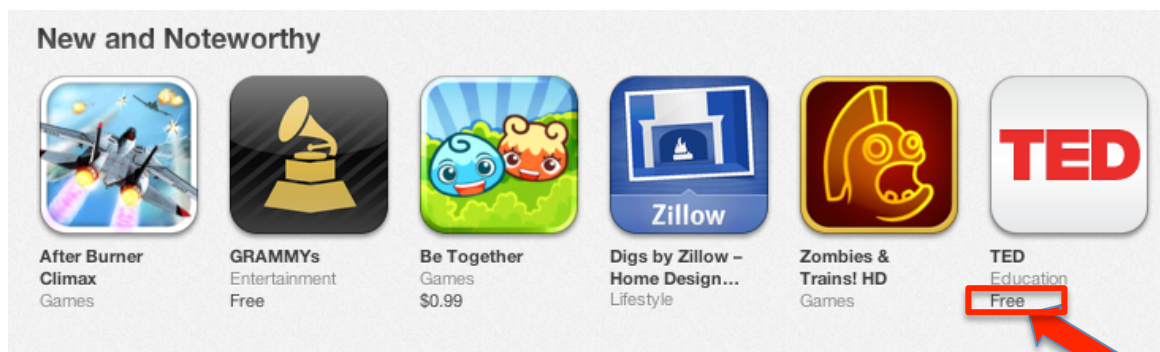
1. Make sure iTunes is loaded on the computer you are using to create the Apple ID.
 - a. Download iTunes here.
2. Open iTunes.
3. Click on App Store menu button at the top of the iTunes window



4. Select the iPad button at the top of the window to see iPad apps only



5. Find a **free** app from the first row of displayed apps



*You may choose **any** free app. It does not have to be TED.*

6. Click on the App icon.

7. Click on the “Free” button below the app icon to begin downloading.



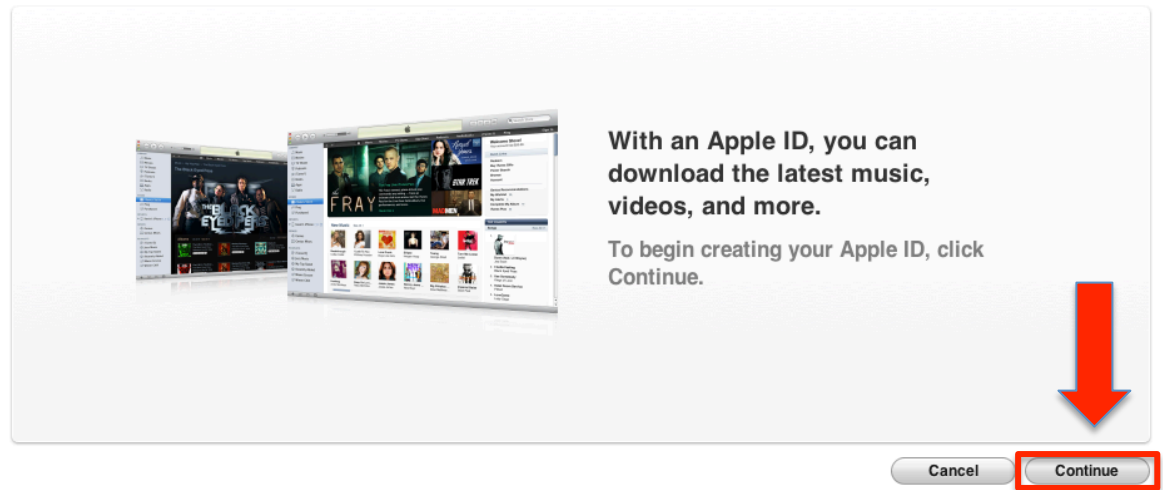
8. A pop-up box will appear. Click the “Create Apple ID” button in the bottom left-hand corner of the pop-up window.



9. A welcome screen will appear. Click on the “Continue” button in the lower right-hand corner.




12. Begin the process of creating your Apple ID by entering a personal email address that you plan to use for your student's Apple ID account.

Note: You may use an email you have already created, or you may create a new one to use for this Apple ID account.





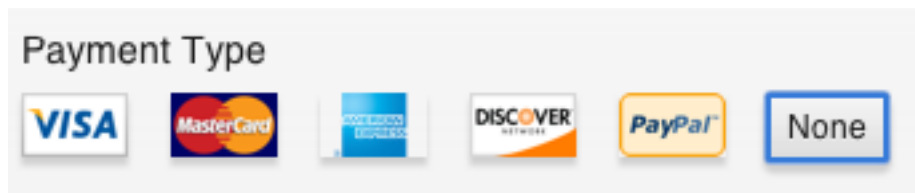
